AL-ANON PREAMBLE

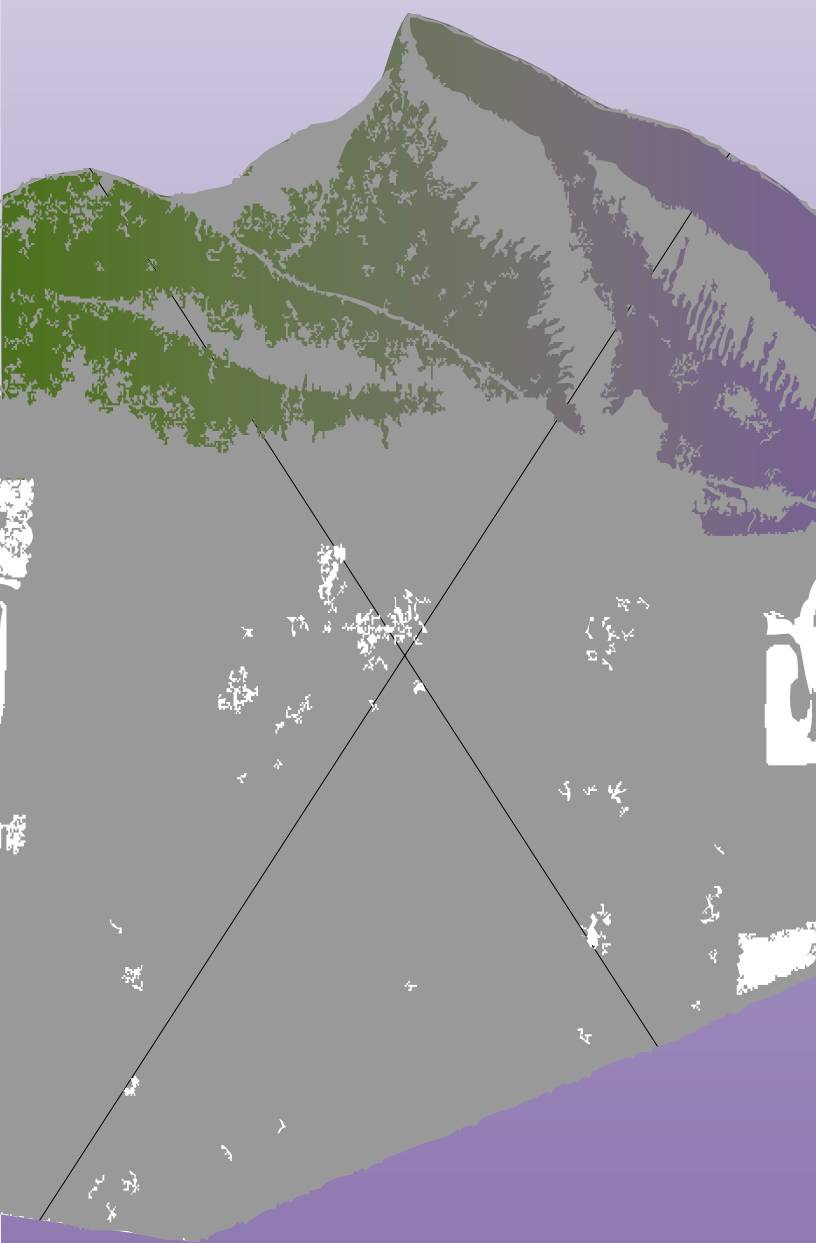

INFANTS' AND TODDLERS' ACTIVITIES (2 MONTHS TO 3 YEARS)

Nursery at Camp CB is \$83 a day & includes toddler lunch.

Infant (2 to 36 months) Program offers a 2:1 infant to attendant ratio and 5:1 toddler to attendant ratio. Program includes organized activities, outside play and quiet time. Nursery is in Camp CB/Whetstone Building and is open 9:00-4:00 Monday thru Saturday.

**Parents must provide: At least 6 diapers, wipes, a change of clothing, comfort item (blanket, pacifier, pillow, special toy, etc.), and a copy of the child's immunization record.

For Infants: provide the above, plus bottles, food, milk/formula. Immunization records can be faxed to 970-349-4173 before arrival.

KIDS ACTIVITIES (3 YEARS TO 14 YEARS)

CAMP CB (ages 5 to 14) & Mini Camp (ages 3 to 4) costs \$63 per day (includes lunch). Programs provide kids an adventure around the mountain with chair lift rides, hikes, adventure park access and crafts.

Camp CB is located in the Whetstone Building and is open from 9:00-4:00 Monday thru Saturday. Camp CB counselors will accompany 7-12 year olds on all activities. Optional activities through Camp CB include zip-line, rafting and mountain biking.

***** Campers should bring hiking shoes, water bottle, sunglasses, sun hat, sunscreen, and fleece jacket for all activities.**
